REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- This completed Application Form
- Letter of Recommendation from high school JROTC senior military instructor (SAI, SNI, etc.)
- Official Georgia High School Transcript
- Copy of SAT and ACT Scores (GMVHOF will accept and award points for both)
- Typed Essay
 - 350 - 400-word essay entitled “**How my education will help me serve my Country in the Military.**” (Essay is to be typed on 8.5x11” paper using Microsoft Word)
- Typed list of extracurricular activities and community involvement. Such as:
 - Academic (Debate Team, JROTC JLAB, Robotics Team, etc.)
 - School or JROTC leadership positions (Senior Class President, JROTC Bn Cdr, Drill Team Commander, etc.)
 - Varsity Sports (played for one entire season, e.g., football, soccer, JROTC Rifle, etc.)
 - Community/Volunteer (part-time job, Boy Scouts, Girls Inc., food bank volunteer, etc.)
- Copy of the *Acceptance Letter* to a Georgia 4-year college/university
- Documentation confirming enrollment in that college/university’s ROTC program (PMS letter)
- Two 8x10 photographs (waist up shot in JROTC uniform)

The photographs will be used for publicity purposes. Awardee’s name and photograph will be posted on the GMVHOF website.

(Optional) Applicants will receive extra points for submitting a nomination packet of a Georgia Veteran for induction into the Georgia Military Veterans Hall of Fame. Please click on the ‘NOMINATION PACKET & INSTRUCTIONS’ on the main page of the GMVHOF website.

GMVHOF JROTC Scholarship Criteria & Selection

- ✓ You must be a Georgia high school senior and enrolled JROTC cadet in good standing
- ✓ The primary criteria for awarding the scholarship will be academic performance in high school and your performance in JROTC. Therefore your transcript, GPA and test scores will be weighted more heavily than the other required items such as Letter of Recommendation, Essay and Extracurricular Activities.
- ✓ The two 8x10 frame-ready color photos are at your expense and must accompany the application packet.
- ✓ The scholarship may only be used at any 4-year accredited Georgia college or university offering college ROTC or serving as an official 'satellite school' of a nearby hosting ROTC college or university.
- ✓ If awarded the GMVHOF JROTC Scholarship, the funds will be paid directly to the college/university ROTC PMS, who will validate your acceptance to that institution, your enrollment in that institution's ROTC program, and that you have officially started your first semester on the date you provided above.
